#### **UN DESA**

The CDP is also responsible for reviewing the status of least developed countries (LDCs) and for monitoring their progress during and after graduation from the category.

#### **SUMMARY**


The 2024 Country Snapshots compile the key statistical data used by the Committee for Development Policy (CDP) at the 2024 triennial review of the least developed country (LDC) category.

LDCs are defined as low-income countries suffering from structural impediments to sustainable development. To identify LDCs, the CDP uses three criteria: gross national income (GNI) per capita; a human assets index (HAI); and an economic and environmental vulnerability index (EVI). HAI and EVI are indices composed of six and eight indicators, respectively. These fourteen indicators, together with the indices for per capita GNI, HAI and EVI, are presented in two-page profiles for each of the 45 countries classified as LDCs in 2024, thus providing a snapshot of each country's situation at the 2024 triennial review. The snapshots also illustrate the gaps in progress towards the LDC graduation thresholds for each country, while comparing individual outcomes with corresponding results for all LDCs and developing countries. Additionally, each snapshot provides a short overview on the country's LDC status and applicable reports and resolutions related to inclusion into and graduation from the LDC category.

A brief introduction to the LDC category and the inclusion and graduation procedures precedes the country snapshots.

## The LDC category

#### LDC definition

Low-income countries confronting severe structural impediments to sustainable development.

#### LDC identification criteria

- Income (GNI per capita).
- Human assets index (HAI).
- Economic and environmental vulnerability index (EVI).

#### Composition of HAI

All HAI indicators carry a weight of 1/6.

#### LDC review


- List of LDCs reviewed triennially by the Committee for Development Policy (CDP).
- Currently 45 countries are included in the list of LDCs.

## Inclusion into the LDC category

#### Inclusion eligibility

Inclusion threshold must be met for all three criteria (GNI per capita, HAI, EVI) at one triennial review.

#### Inclusion thresholds (2024 triennial review)

GNI per capita: \$1,088 or below
HAI: 60 or below
EVI: 36 or above

#### Inclusion procedure

- UN DESA formally notifies country of eligibility finding.
- \* CDP submits inclusion recommendation to the UN Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC).
- \* ECOSOC endorses the recommendation by the CDP.
- Country formally notifies the Secretary-General of its acceptance.
- General Assembly takes note of the ECOSOC recommendation.
- Inclusion takes effect immediately.

## Graduation from the LDC category

#### **Graduation eligibility**

Graduation threshold must be met for two of the three criteria (GNI per capita, HAI, EVI) at two consecutive triennial reviews.

#### Graduation thresholds (2024 triennial review)

GNI per capita: \$1,306 or above
HAI: 66 or above
EVI: 32 or below

#### **Graduation procedure**

- After LDC has met the graduation criteria for the first time, UNCTAD prepares a vulnerability profile and UN DESA prepares an ex-ante impact assessment and as inputs to the CDP's decision-making process.
- Country is invited to present its views on the possibility of graduation at the CDP expert group meeting preceding the next triennial review and in writing at the CDP Plenary.
- CDP recommends the country for graduation based on the LDC criteria and additional country-specific information (supplementary graduation indicators, an assessment based on the inputs by UN DESA, UNCTAD and other UN entities, country view).
- Any recommendation for graduation includes a statement on length of preparatory period and suggestions for policy priorities and support needs for a smooth transition.
- \* ECOSOC endorses the recommendation of the CDP.
- General Assembly takes note of the decision of ECOSOC.
- Graduation takes effect at the end of the preparatory period (three years or an extended period of up to five years in case of country-specific circumstances) after the decision by the General Assembly.

#### Preparation for graduation

- During the preparatory period before graduation is effective, country still belongs to the LDC category and is entitled to receive all benefits available to LDC.
- \* Country is invited to prepare a transition strategy in cooperation with development partners.
- \* CDP monitors development progress of the country and the preparation of the transition strategy through its enhanced monitoring mechanism (EMM).

#### Smooth transition from the LDC category

- After graduation is effective, country no longer belongs to the LDC category.
- \* LDC-specific support should be phased out gradually and in a predictable manner after graduation.
- \* Country implements the transition strategy, supported by development partners.
- CDP monitors development progress of the country and the implementation of the transition strategy through its EMM for three consecutive years after graduation takes effect, then triennially at two triennial reviews.


