


Leaving the LDC category

Graduation thresholds for any two of the three graduation criteria (alternatively, income-only criterion) must be met in two consecutive triennial reviews to be considered for graduation



Per capita GNI

2018 graduation threshold: \$1,230 or above 2018 income-only threshold: \$2,460 or above



Economic vulnerability index (EVI)

2018 graduation threshold: 32 or below



Human assets index (HAI)

2018 graduation threshold: 66 or above
