

Dr. William Moomaw is Professor of International Environmental Policy and Director of the center for International Environment and Resource Policy at The Fletcher School, Tufts University. He earned a PhD in physical chemistry at MIT, and has worked on stratospheric ozone, climate, energy, forests, water and sustainable development issues for over 20 years. He has served as a lead author for four IPCC reports addressing mitigation options in the context of development. He is currently a coordinating lead author of the IPCC report, Renewable Energy and Climate Change that is due in December 2010. He has led training sessions for climate, environment and resource negotiations, facilitated negotiations and written reports for the United Nations and other international organizations.
