Report on the Seventeenth session of the CDP

Advance unedited version of the report on the Fifteenth session of the CDP is available. The report addresses the following themes: the triennial review of the list of LDCs and eligibility for graduation and inclusion; effective accountability for sustainable development in the post-2015 era; the new financing for development landscape; refining the indicators employed for the identification of LDCs; CDP work programme for April 2015 - March 2016.
